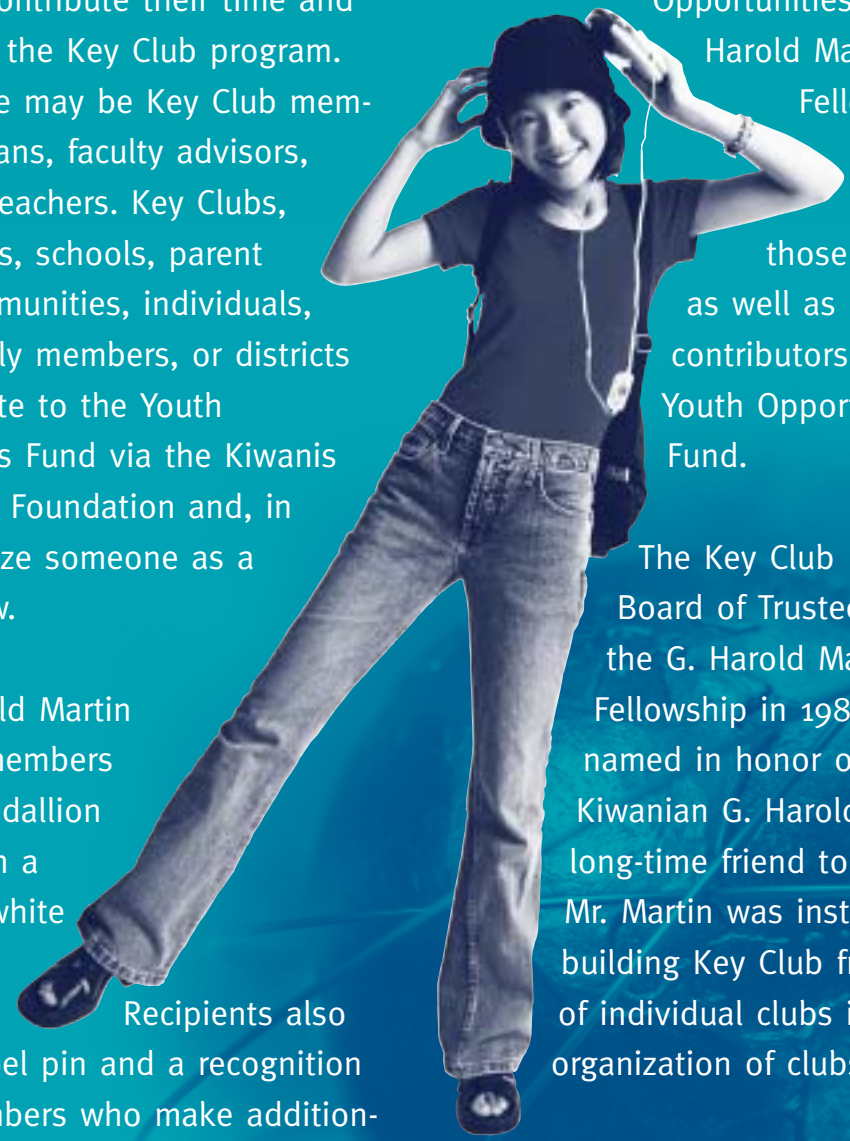
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The G. Harold Martin Fellowship also is a means to recognize people who unselfishly contribute their time and resources to the Key Club program. These people may be Key Club members, Kiwanians, faculty advisors, parents, or teachers. Key Clubs, Kiwanis clubs, schools, parent groups, communities, individuals, Kiwanis-family members, or districts can all donate to the Youth Opportunities Fund via the Kiwanis International Foundation and, in turn, recognize someone as a Martin Fellow.

New G. Harold Martin Fellowship members receive a medallion hanging from a yellow and white ribbon.

Recipients also receive a lapel pin and a recognition plaque. Members who make additional US\$250 contributions attain diamond-level status. Diamond recipients receive a diamond lapel pin.



Each year at the Key Club International convention, a Youth Opportunities Fund/G. Harold Martin Fellowship reception recognizes those members, as well as other contributors to the Youth Opportunities Fund.

The Key Club International Board of Trustees created the G. Harold Martin Fellowship in 1981. It is named in honor of Florida Kiwanian G. Harold Martin, a long-time friend to Key Club. Mr. Martin was instrumental in building Key Club from a group of individual clubs into an organization of clubs.
