Denoted by the color green - the color of life, of plants and of spring - green is the color of the seasonal renewal and the triumph of spring over cold winter and thus of Hope and Immortality.

The Shaffer Honorary is the highest level of recognition offered by the Youth Opportunity Fund within the Kiwanis International Foundation.

The Shaffer Honorary contributions can be made on behalf of an individual or an entity such as a club, corporation, or organization. The purpose of the Shaffer Honorary is to recognize someone special whose life is dedicated to supporting Key Club activities.

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A.G. TERRY SHAFFER HONORARY ORDER FORM

This award is named after A.G. Terry Shaffer, the epitome of Kiwanis. Terry began his Kiwanisfamily adventure as a member of Key Club at Sunbury High School in Sunbury, Pennsylvania. Terry went on to serve as club president of three Kiwanis clubs: Selinsgrove, Pennsylvania; Southeast Area, Chicago; and Northwest Indianapolis. He served as secretary of those three clubs and the Kiwanis Club of Tri-Village, Rich Township, Illinois. He also served as lieutenant governor of Division 12, Pennsylvania District,

for two years, and as district chairman of three committees of the Pennsylvania District. One of those committees was Key Club, and 44 new Key Clubs were built during that three-year period.

Terry also served as a member of the International Committee on Key Clubs during Kiwanis International's golden anniversary year of 1965. Terry was a member of the International Office staff for nearly 35 years, from 1969 to 2004. He held a wide variety of responsibilities on the Kiwanis International staff ranging from manager of club services, to Circle K International administrator, to International Secretary. In 1998, the title of International Secretary was changed to Executive Director. Terry served as Executive Director until his successor was named on January 8, 2004. He then served as the organization's Archivist/Historian.

Upon his retirement, the International Board of Trustees named him Executive Director Emeritus. Terry's life was cut short by cancer and he passed away in 2005. He is survived by his widow, Nancy Shaffer.

Recipients are presented an attractive award designed specifically for the Shaffer Honorary. The award signifies that a minimum contribution of US\$1,000 has been given. Shaffer Honorary proceeds are placed in the Key Club International Youth Opportunity Fund. Held within the Kiwanis International Foundation, this endowment fund's earnings will be used to provide grants in support of Key Club community-service projects and scholarships.
